Getting There

Stirling Enterprise Park (STEP) is on Players Road: postcode FK7 7RP, grid reference NS801931. Players Road is accessed from the A905 Kerse Road: if travelling from Stirling town centre turn left at the first roundabout after the railway bridge, STEP is ~ 300m ahead. There is plenty of parking behind the building (on the north side). If you are coming by train it is easier to cross the railway using the footbridge at the station and walk south until you reach STEP.
