


## **Making Connections**




# **Introducing Fauna & Flora**

By working to protect nature, we help secure the rights and well-being of the people living locally, with whom we work.






## Biodiversity Credits and the Development of a High-Integrity Biodiversity Credit Market

#### 2019 Argyll Hope Spot and Community Support Fund

•Dr Sylvia Earle's foundation, Mission Blue, declares its first ever Hope Spot in the UK and Fauna & Flora establishes the CSF '

#### 2017 Coastal Communities Network (CCN)

•CCN emerges with 8 community based groups and within 2 years has a seat at the table of government working groups

#### Community-led Marine Biodiversity Monitoring Project

•Innovative partnership with Nature Scot

#### Fair Isle Demonstration & Research MPA

• First ever statutory community-led marine management

#### 2014-2015 New Coastal Community Groups

•Community Association of Lochs and Sounds (CAOLAS) and Craignish Restoration of Marine and Coastal Habitat (CROMACH).








## **CWA and F&F/CCN Similarities**



### CWA Member Woodlands (~200)













